Goals

Goal #1: University Libraries will engage university and local communities through outreach, teaching, and collaborative activities.

1. **Strategy:** Build partnerships with campus and community groups to support the mission of University Libraries.
2. **Strategy:** Provide instructional support to teaching faculty. Assess and enhance librarian teaching practices related to information literacy and research skills with the goal of creating inclusive, learner-centered experiences.
3. **Strategy:** Promote collections, services, and activities to users.
4. **Strategy:** Provide focused outreach to increase knowledge and use of library resources, collections, and services.
5. **Strategy:** Conduct usability studies of the Libraries' web presence with the campus community to enhance the user experience.

Goal #2: University Libraries will strive to make public collections and spaces, both physical and virtual, accessible and inviting to all members of the University community.

1. **Strategy:** Comply with University provided accessibility standards to enhance the library experience.
3. **Strategy:** Provide access to collections and services for remote users.
4. **Strategy:** Create and enhance collection records to improve discoverability and provide more equitable access to resources.
5. **Strategy:** Support the maintenance and visibility of digitally created resources and the digitization of unique physical collections.

Goal #3: University Libraries will embrace emerging technologies that enhance user experience, improve employee efficiency, and support the Libraries' mission.

1. **Strategy:** Collaboratively investigate the technology needs of library users and staff to improve user experience and promote effective use of technology.
2. **Strategy:** Explore and pursue external funding to incorporate new technologies.

Goal #4: University Libraries will foster diversity, equity, and inclusion (DEI) through its collections, services, spaces, and staffing.

1. **Strategy:** Develop collections that emphasize diversity, equity, and inclusion.

2. **Strategy:** Explore the use of alternative subject vocabularies and incorporate inclusive descriptive terminology for library collections.
3. **Strategy:** Foster a diverse workforce by re-examining recruitment, hiring practices, and search committee training to align with DEI principles.
4. **Strategy:** Educate library users on the value of open access educational resources and explore sustainable scholarly publishing models to promote equitable access to information.

Goal #5: University Libraries will recruit, develop, and retain outstanding employees.

1. **Strategy:** Promote University Libraries as a welcoming place to work where ideas and diverse voices are welcomed and respected.
2. **Strategy:** Empower employees in decision-making processes by asking for valued input.
3. **Strategy:** Distribute publicity internally and to library affiliates to keep employees informed on all activities in the University Libraries.
4. **Strategy:** Explore opportunities to address salary compression and upgrade staff positions.
5. **Strategy:** Support on-the-job training, cross-training, workshops, and enhanced professional development opportunities.

Goal #6: University Libraries will build, maintain, and preserve robust collections and resources to meet the diverse information needs of the University community.

1. **Strategy:** Identify additional external funding sources and consortia that can be used to enhance collections.
2. **Strategy:** Ensure the library collections support teaching, learning, and the research needs of users.
3. **Strategy:** Maintain optimal environmental conditions and recommend upgrades for preserving physical and digital collections.
4. **Strategy:** Review library collections through collection analysis and deselection.
5. **Strategy:** Create a data/metric-based formula for establishing the Libraries' collections budgets.
